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## **SunRiver Remains Top Pick Nationwide**

**St. George, UT, June 17, 2009** –*Where to Retire* magazine, a national publication reaching half a million readers each month, has once again named SunRiver St. George one of “America’s 100 Best Master-Planned Communities.” SunRiver has received the coveted designation nine times since 1999 and is the only development in Utah to make the list this year.

The listing, which appears in the July-August 2009 issue of the magazine, describes SunRiver as a place “for retirees who don’t want to act their age,” citing the lavish community center with its fitness facilities, pools, and extension courses from Dixie State College as a key component of the retirement lifestyle to be enjoyed there.

Karen Northridge, the magazine’s publisher, stated that the recognition is a result of a process that involved reviewing several hundred communities all over America. Those selected, she said, are “among an elite group of developments that offer today’s retirees a well-rounded, active lifestyle.”

She also pointed out that the communities receiving the designation all have “a positive impact . . . on the economic health of the towns and cities in which they are located.”

Commenting on the award, SunRiver’s developer, Darcy Stewart, said, “This recognition by a prestigious national publication demonstrates our continuing commitment to create a lifestyle second to none for our residents, even in an adverse economic climate.
